SUMMARY JUDGEMENT: 27.01.2023

Brief facts of the case in hand are that the plaintiff, Rasool

Khan has brought the instant suit for declaration cum perpetual and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that correct name of his father is Dilbaz and his correct address is Qoum name of his father is Dilbaz and his correct address is Qoum Khadizai in his CNIC by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. That the father name of the plaintiff is correctly mentioned as Dilbaz in the CNIC of Muhammad

Sharif (brother of the plaintiff). That the defendants were

repeatedly asked to correct the date of birth and address of the plaintiff but they refused, hence, the instant suit.

- 2. Defendants were summoned, who appeared through their representative namely Mr. Irfan Hussain, who submitted written statement.
- order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record.

his CNIC by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. Plaintiff in support of his contention produced CNICs of his brothers namely Muhammad Sharif, Syed Jan and Isla Jan wherein their father's name is mentioned as Dilbaz R/O Qoum Mamozai. So, the CNICs of the brothers of the plaintiff clearly negate the incorporation of his father's name and address as Dilbaz Khan R/O Qoum Khadizai in his CNIC. Further, there is no countered document available with the defendants to rebut the documents produced by the plaintiff in support of his stance, which establishes that the father's and address of the plaintiff has wrongly been MAN Could be a second of the course of the facts and course of the facts and course of the facts and the facts are considered.
