2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 26.01. 2023 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

Petitioner No. 1) Mst Laiq Mina (Widow), 2) Mst Zalfa Bibi (Daughter), 3) Mst Laja Bibi (Daughter), 4) Mst Munir Bibi (Daughter), 05) Muhammad Ameen (Son), 06) Mst Shaka Bibi (Daughter), 07) Mst Mashal Begum (Daughter), 08) Muhammad Ameen (Son) and 09) Ajmal Khan (Son) filed the instant application. Muhámmad Ameen (attorney) recorded his statement as PW-1, Sakhi Muhammad as PW-2 and Abdullah as PW-3 testified respectively. PW-1 submitted his power of attorney as Ex.PW-1/1, copy of his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/2, Copy of death certificate of deceased as Ex.PW-1/3, Bank Account statement as PW-1/4 and FRC as Ex.PW-1/5. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.
