ORDER

APP, Nisar Ahmad for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Waseem Akram** s/o Malak Jaan seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 117, dated 20.11.2022 registered U/S 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA, 2019 and 336/337-A(ii)/337-G/427/279 PPC at Police Station Kalaya, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant Shal Muhammad SHO acting on information regarding smuggling of huge quantity of narcotics by Waseem Akram, the accused/petitioner, via motorcycle on main road leading from Tarkhosam to Anjari Bazar, laid a picket on the spot where a motorcycle riding by the accused/petitioner was signaled to stop but the accused/petitioner instead of complying the signal hit constable Muhammad Younas with a

motorcycle who received injuries while the accused/petitioner himself fell down of the motorcycle and received injury. The accused/petitioner was wearing 02 grey colour waistcoats, the search of the which led the complainant to the recovery of 17 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 17,000 grams. Hence, the present FIR.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession and the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connects the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
