





Order	28/01/2023	<p>Mr. Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner; the father of deceased in person and APP for State are in attendance.</p> <p>2. Arguments heard; whereas, this is the disposal of petition for grant of bail, submitted by accused/petitioner Juma Gul son of Lal Badshah resident of Qaum Mishti Tappa Haider Khel, District Orakzai.</p> <p>3. Juma Gul reported the incident of opening fire over his nephew Azi Ullah (deceased) against some unknown person. FIR bearing No. 1 dated 09-01-2023 was registered under Section 324 Pakistan Panel Code, 1860. The injured was later on succumbed to death and the father of deceased namely Watan Badshah recorded his statement under Section 164 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 charging therein his brother Juma Gul (the complainant) for abetment as co-accused and his nephew Hafeez Ullah as principal accused. Section 302/109/34 of Pakistan Panel Code, 1860 have been added and complainant was arrested as co-accused on the score of abetment by issuing advice of murdering deceased.</p> <p>4. The father of deceased appeared before the Court and stated at the bar that principal accused is Hafeez Ullah who is absconding and the accused behind the bar is responsible only to the extent of abetment. The accused behind the bar is real brother and charged for offence of lesser punishment; therefore, he has no objection if Bail is granted to him. To this extent, his statement was recorded in the Court and his CNIC was exhibited as Ex.PA.</p> <p>5. For what has been discussed above, the petition stands allowed on the basis of statement of the father of deceased. The accused/petitioner is released on bail subject</p>
