-		alleged fraud and mis-representation on the part of the respondents but have not disclosed the alleged fraud and mis-representation in his petition. He has also not suggested any relevancy through any means available on case file with the property decreed in favour of the contesting respondents. During arguments, the counsel for the petitioner drew the attention of the court towards a document which is Ex.PW-1/2, available in the original case file whereby the name of the one Jameel Khan is mentioned and it was alleged that this was the father of the present petitioner but as per the petition, the name of the father of the petitioner is Muhammad Jameel and not Jameel Khan and no other document in the shape of CNIC etc has been annexed with the petition from which it could be presumed that this Jameel Khan is in fact the one Muhammad Jameel, who is the father of the petitioner.  Thus, in the light of the aforesaid findings, the present petition is not maintainable and would be a futile exercise and wastage of the precious time of the court if kept pending, hence, dismissed with costs.
