Petitioners present through counsel and attorney.

Inquiry report has been returned and placed on file. Publication received but none present on behalf of public at large. Hence, public at large is proceeded ex-parte.

Petitioner's evidence recorded and closed. Arguments heard and record perused.

Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 15.02. 2023 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

PW-1 submitted his power of attorney as Ex.PW-1/1, copy of his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/2, copy of death certificate of deceased as Ex.PW-1/3, FRC as Ex.PW-1/4, Saving Certificates consist of 08 pages as Ex.PW-1/5, Copy of CNIC cancellation form of deceased as Ex.PW-1/6. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

The available record on file prima facie establishes that petitioners are the legal heirs of deceased Noor Marjan as there is

The share of minors at serial No. 7 & 8 be deposited to the official account of Senior Civil Judge, Orakzai.
