DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Aurangzeb Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Arguments heard and record gone through.

Accused/petitioner, Masood s/o Mashal

Shah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 10, dated 27.02.2023 registered U/S 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA, 2019 at Police Station Mishti Mela, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant acting on information Sions Merregarding smuggling of narcotics via black colour bearing Registration No. motorcar KWB999/Punjab towards Kohat, laid a picket on the spot where at about 1100 hours a black colour motorcar driving by accused/petitioner was stopped. The accused/petitioner was deboarded and his person was searched but nothing incriminating was recovered from him. However, search of motorcar led the complainant to the



recovery of 09 packets of chars, each weighing 1100 grams, making a total of 9900 grams, from a secret cavity of the motorcar. Hence, the present FIR.

It is evident from the record that the 3. accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his offence for which the The possession. accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably accused/petitioner with the connect the commission of offence. The points raised by the learned counsel for accused/petitioner involve deep appreciation of merits which cannot be discussed bail stage. Hence, accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
