Complainant is absent despite service. Record received. Arguments heard and record perused.

Accused/petitioners namely Abdullah S/O Khaista Rehman and Imtiaz S/O Qamar Khel, both R/O Qaum Bezote, Village Mir Kalay Khel, Muslim Abad, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai are seeking their post arrest bail in Case FIR No.28 dated: 27.03.2022 U/S 506, 504, 341, 148, 149 PPC, Police Station Kalaya, District Orakzai.

Perusal of record reveals that there is unexplained delay in lodging of report and registration of FIR. The offences U/S 504 and 341 PPC are bailable while offence U/S 506 PPC does not fall within the ambit of prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.PC. In such like cases grant of bail is a rule and refusal is an exception. No extra ordinary circumstances exist to justify the departure from the said rule. Co-accused with similar role have already been released on post arrest bail, therefore, rule of consistency apply to the case of accused/petitioners. Investigation has already been completed and accused/petitioners are no more required to the local police for further investigation and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/petitioners behind the bar.
