

Order No 12	16.03.2023	<p>Plaintiff through counsel present.</p> <p>Through my this single order, I intend to dispose off the instant suit ex-parte, filed by the plaintiff against the defendants.</p> <p>Brief facts of the case are that the plaintiff filed the instant suit for declaration-cum-perpetual & mandatory injunction and possession to the effect that the suit property was the ownership of the father of the plaintiff and after his death, the same devolved upon the plaintiff and her mother but later on her mother also died and resultantly the whole of the suit property devolved upon the plaintiff and she became the sole owner in possession of the same while the defendants have nothing to do with the same.
