Parties present. Arguments on point of maintainability of the contempt of

court petition already heard and record perused.

Brief but relevant facts are that the present petitioners filed a civil suit

titled Manzoor Ali and others Vs Asal Badshah and others on 15.02.2023 and

an application for grant of temporary injunction was annexed with the plaint and

after hearing the preliminary arguments on the application, status quo was

granted on the suit property vide order dated: 15.02.2023. The petitioner handed

over copy of stay order to SHO on 16.02.2023 but the same was not

implemented.

Petitioners have contended that defendants have violated order dated:

15.02.2023 passed by this court by leveling/making play ground in the suit

property, therefore, respondents be proceeded against accordingly.

Keeping in yiew the pleadings and available record on file that the instant

petition is not maintainable and no further evidence is required in the same for

the reasons mentioned hereinafter.

There is nothing on record which could show that respondent No. 2

violated the court order. Furthermore, court bailiff was directed to visit the spot

and submit his report. Report of court bailiff/process server dated: 04.03.2023 is

placed on file as per which the suit property consists of ground and is used for

playing cricket. The report further states that no construction activity is evident

on the spot. Petitioners failed to establish that respondents have violated

injunctive order of the court, resultantly, petition in hand stands Dismissed. No

order as to cost.
