

Order	22.03.2023	<p>Accused/petitioner Imtiaz on ad-interim pre-arrest bail along with counsel present. Complainant along with counsel and APP for State are also in attendance.</p> <p>2. This is the disposal of Pre arrest bail application presented by accused/petitioner Imtiaz resident of Qaum Bezot, Tappa Qambar Khel, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai.</p> <p>3. Mutasim Khan complainant, charging the accused including present petitioner for unlawfully blocking coal mining passage and unlawful assembly for advancing threats of dire consequences to the complainant. Naqalmad No.7 dated 23-03-2022 was converted into FIR bearing No.28 dated 27-03-2022, registered at Police Station, Kalaya under sections 504/506/341/148/149 of the Pakistan Penal Code-1860. The above named petitioner presented instant pre-arrest bail petition, which is under consideration.</p> <p>4. Arguments of counsel for the accused/petitioner and APP for State assisted by counsel for the complainant heard and record perused.</p> <p>5. On tentative assessment of record, it reveals that petitioner has specifically been named in the contents of FIR. Neither mala fide nor intention to disgrace, humiliation, harassment and dishonor on part of the complainant or prosecution is being surfaced.</p> <p>6. For what has been discussed above, instant pre arrest bail petition stands dismissed. Ad-interim pre arrest bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioner namely Abdullah is hereby recalled.</p> <p>7. File of this Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.</p> <p>8.
