of exercise of discretion judiciously. Perusal of the case record would reveal that in the course of investigation, the vehicle mentioned above was taken into possession by police vide Recovery Memo dated 13.04.2023. The petitioner produced the original of documents annexed with the petition (original seen and returned); whereas, photo copies of the documents retained on record. The owner is the father of complainant/petitioner who is before the Court recorded his statement in favour of his son who is last possessor. The CNIC of the recorded owner is Ex.PA, CNIC of the complainant being last possessor is Ex.PB-1 and copy of registration book is Ex.PB. At the moment, there is no rival claimant before the Court as well. Further, no useful purpose will be served if the vehicle is retained in the custody of the local police rather it will damage its physical condition. Hence, the same be returned to petitioner by furnishing surety bonds in the sum of Rs.500,000/-(five lacs); with two sureties; each in the like amount, to the satisfaction of SHO concerned subject to the condition that the petitioner shall produce the same during trial, if required. Petitioner is further directed not to dispose of the Motorcycle till disposal of the case.
