



Hence, in view of above, the impugned order dated 27.03.2023 of the learned trial court is modified to the extent that status quo on the spot be maintained by both the parties till date fixed before the learned trial court. The instant miscellaneous civil appeal is disposed of in view of the afore-mentioned directions. Consigned.
