Perusal of the record reveal that accused/petitioners are charged for offences u/s 341,186,188,189,147,149 PPC.

Offences u/s 341,186,189,147,149 PPC are bailable in nature. Though offence u/s 188 is non bailable yet the punishment provided for such offence does not attract prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC, hence the grant of bail in such cases is a rule while its refusal as exception, however, no exceptional circumstances exists in instant case. The accused/petitioners are neither previous convicted nor they have confessed their guilt.

For above, accused are entitled to the concession of bail at this stage, hence, application in hand is accepted and accused are released on bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds to the tune of Rs: 80,000/- with two local sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court.
