APP for the state present. Counsel for the accused/petitioner present. Complainant in person present and produced wakalat nama but despite repeated directions, no counsel is produced. On last date of hearing, complainant was given adjournment of six days to engage counsel and prepare case. APP is directed to argue the case on the behalf of the complainant.

The petitioners namely Syed Salam s/o Movi Khan and Muhammad Younas S/O Syed Salam have applied for his post arrest bail in connection with case FIR No. 01 dated 30/05/2019 u/s 341-506/34 PPC registered in PS Ghiljo Upper Orakzai.

Arguments heard and file perused.

Admittedly, accused is directly charged in the FIR, however, no recovery has been affected. Moreover, no eye witness of occurrence is present which makes the instant case that of further inquiry. Further, there is considerable delay of 24 hours in report, which is explained by the complainant. Furthermore, the offences, for which accused are charged, do not come within the prohibitory clause of 497 CrPC.

Hence, for the reasons above, petitioners/ accused are admitted to the concession of bail. Accused be released on bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds to tune of Rs. 50,000/- with two local and reliable sureties each with the like amount to the satisfaction of this court.
