Petitioners present through counsel.

Arguments heard and record gone through.

Petitioners have filed instant petition for issuance of amended succession certificate to the effect that succession certificate was issued by this court on 19-06-2020 in favour of petitioners regarding the legacy of Habeeb Gul. That at the time of filing petition for succession certificate, cash amount Rs. 429,601/- were lying in the account of deceased. However, later on, profit was added to the said amount and at present the said amount is Rs. 641,805/- but the succession certificate issued by the court is only regarding amount Rs. 429,601/-. Hence, it is requested that amended certificate be issued by incorporating amount as Rs. 641,805/- while the account number of deceased as "3113734706" NBP at Hangu.

Perusal of the record reveals that petitioners alongwith the petition have annexed the bank statement of deceased and the same is Ex.PW-1/9 wherein the amount has been mentioned as 429,601/-. Record reveals that the same statement was issued in the month of October, 2019 while the bank statement of the deceased issued in the month of July, 2020 depicts that profit and outstanding salaries of deceased were also added and the same amount enhanced to the Rs. 641,805/-. Similarly, record depicts that no number of account of deceased was mentioned in the succession certificate issued by the court. Hence, the request of petitioners for mentioning the cash amount as Rs. 641,805/- and Ac/No as "3113734706" in the succession certificate seems genuine. By accepting application in hand amended succession certificate is hereby issued by mentioning the
