Petitioner through Syed Lal Qasim as attorney for petitioner along with counsel present. The petitioner seeks succession certificate in respect of legacy of deceased namely Syed Awan Hussain, who died on 29/10/2018. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 31st July, 2019 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

3. Petitioner Isam Zahra, filed the instant application. Attorney of the petitioner recorded his statement as PW-1, while Syed Ibn-el-Hassan as PW-2 and Syed Abdullah Jan as PW-3 testified respectively. PW-1 submitted his power of attorney as Ex. PW-1/6 and copy of his CNIC as Ex. PW-1/1, copy of death certificate of deceased as Ex. PW-1/3, copy of deceased CNIC is Ex. PW-1/4, copy of CNIC of petitioner is Ex. PW-1/4 (A), copy of Account Balance enquiry report as Ex. PW- 1/5 Copies of CNICs of PW-2 and PW-3 is Ex. PW-2/1 and Ex. PW-3/1. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.


5. As, there is no other legal heir of deceased and considering the request of the petitioner being genuine this application is allowed along with accrued profit and Succession Certificate is issued in favour of
