<u>Order - 6</u> 18/09/2020

Petitioner through attorney, Inam Badshah and counsel present. The petitioners seek succession certificate in respect of legacy of deceased namely Bakhtawar Gul, who died on 23.11.2019. Arguments heard and record perused.

Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 17th July, 2020 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

Petitioner No. 01 Mst Umrah (widow), 02. Haroon Gul (Son), 03. Saadia Bibi (Daughter), 04. Bilal (Son) 05. Khamia Bibi (Daughter) 06. Zahra Bibi (Daughter) 07. Hadia Bibi (Daughter) 08. Nafeesa Bibi and 09. Amina Bibi have filed the instant application. Inaam Badshah recorded his statement as PW-1, Shaheen Badshah as PW-2 and Alif Khan as PW-3 testified respectively. PW-1 submitted death certificate of deceased as Ex.PW-1/1, CNIC of petitioner No.1 as Ex.PW-1/2, family registration certificate and Form-B of petitioner No. 2 to 9 as Ex.PW-1/3 and 1/4, Bank statement as Ex.PW-1/5, Copy of his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/6 and his power of attorney as Ex.PW-1/7. PW-02 and PW-03 submitted copies of their CNICs as Ex.PW-2/1 and Ex.PW-3/1 respectively. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

As, there is nothing in rebuttal, so therefore contention of the petitioners is believed to be correct. Therefore, the petitioners will inherit the legacy of deceased as per following shares;

As, there is no other legal heir of deceased and considering the request of the petitioners being genuine this application is allowed along with accrued profit and Succession Certificate is issued in favour of petitioners, subject to surety bond/undertaking to the tune of Rs. 100,000 with 02 local sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. If any legal heir/objector appear in future, the petitioners and the sureties will be responsible for the payment. Parties are left to bear their own cost. Original succession certificate be given to the petitioner subject to surety bonds while copy of the certificate be placed on file.
