DPP, Umar Niaz for State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioners, Muhammad Yasin and Muhammad Ilyas seek their release on bail in case FIR No. 44, dated 18.09.2020 registered U/S 324/34 PPC § 15AA at Police Station Upper Orakzai Ghiljo, wherein they are charged for making firing at the complainant by means of firearm and thereby causing injuries to him and his brother.

2. Today, injured/complainant Muhammad Sadiq and injured Nasir Khan present and submitted compromise affidavit Ex. PA, and by recording joint statement deposed that they have patched up the matter with the accused and have forgiven them in the name Almighty Allah by waving of their right of qisas and diyat and have got no objection either on the release of accused/petitioners on bail or upon their acquittal at the time of trial. The elders of the locality namely, Nasib Khan and Muhammad Kamil also present and



verified the parties as well as the genuineness of compromise.

3. Since, the offence is compoundable and from the compromise produced in black and white, this court is satisfied that a genuine compromise between the parties has taken place and accordingly, the said compromise is accepted and on the basis of compromise, the bail petition in hand stand accepted and accused/petitioners are admitted to bail in sum of rupees 100,000 with two sureties each, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court.
