ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioners, Amin Afzal and Abdul Rabi seek their release on bail in case FIR No. 49, dated 07.10.2020 registered U/S 9 (d) CNSA at Police Station Upper Orakzai, wherein they are charged for having 01 packets of chars, weighing 1200 grams, recovered from the side pocket of the motorcycle.

3. From the arguments and record available on file, it reveals that the FSL report is not available on the case file to determine the nature of substance recovered. Accused/petitioners, after their arrest, have gone through the process of investigation but neither they confessed their guilt nor anything incriminating recovered from their

possession during the said period of investigation.
No past criminal history either of involvement or conviction of the accused/petitioners was brought on record. As such, further enquiry would be attracted to the case of accused/petitioners and their case is thus arguable for the purpose of bail.

4. Accordingly, for the reasons briefly mentioned above, bail petition in hand stand accepted and accused/petitioners are admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court.

5. Police record be returned and file of this court be consigned to record room.
