JUDGEMENT 20.06.2020

The petitioner, Ahmad Ullah through the petition in hand requested for the registration of FIR against Fazal Jamil and Syed Rasool to the effect that on 11.06.2020 at about 11:30 AM, they trespassed into their property illegally, beaten the minors, abused the female folk and by aiming their Kalashnikovs restrained them from working in the fields. The comments of the local police is not favouring the petitioner besides the matter is more or less is a civil dispute already pending adjudication before the competent court of law where the parties could
