Arguments for the learned counsel for the accused/petitioner and

APP for the state heard today and record perused.

The offence u/s 56 (1) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mineral

Sector Governance Act 2017 is cognizable and non-bailable and the

information of the offence shall be reported to the PS by the licencing

authority or an officer authorize by it in this behalf for registration of

case against the accused as provided u/s 56 (5) of the Act. The

licencing authority under the Act is the committee constituted u/s 6 of

the Act or the Director General of Mines and Minerals for the purpose

of reporting the offence to the PS. In the instant case against the

accused/petitioner the offence is reported to the police by Mineral

Guard who is neither the licencing authority nor authorized officer to

lodge the report which shows mala fide on the part of complainant to register the case against the accused/petitioner in violation of section 56 (5) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mineral Sector Governance Act 2017. It is a well settled principle of law that when the law requires a particular thing to be done in a particular manner then it should be done in that manner as provided under the law and not otherwise. The accused/petitioner has joined the investigation and it will bear no fruitful result to send him behind the bars.

In view the above, the bail petition in hand is accepted and the ad-interim pre-arrest bail granted to the accused/petitioner vide order dated 19/12/2020 is hereby confirmed on the strength existing bail bonds.
