In these circumstances, the instant pre-arrest bail petition of the accused/petitioners, Shamsher Abbas and Shah Nawaz Ali, is dismissed. Copy of this order be placed on record and the same be returned to the quarter concerned; while file of this Court be consigned to the record room after necessary completion and compilation.
