DPP, Umar Niaz for the state and Jabir Hussain Advocate for petitioner present. Comments of SHO already received and placed on file.

Arguments heard and record perused.

(2). Petitioner, Muhammad Yousaf through petition u/s 22-A Cr.P.C requested for the registration of FIR against respondent no. 2 Noor Muhammad s/o Nizam Din for snatching the car of the petitioner at gun point. The SHO in his comments submitted that as per the version of the respondent recorded by him, the car of the petitioner has not been snatched but rather the petitioner has sold it out to respondent no. 2 for Rs. 860,000/- for the payment of one month wherein Rs. 10,000/- was paid in advance. The respondent has taken the plea that he has further sold it out in favour of one, Zar Wali Khan but the amount of the petitioner is outstanding against him.

(3). It is surprising that despite allegation of cognizable offence, no proceedings were carried out upon the application of the petitioner and rather the version of the respondent have been placed on record without any version of the petitioner to be placed therein and without FIR being registered for the offence.
