The accused/petitioners (1) Gul Nawaz and (2) Meer Nawaz, both sons of Muhammad Yousaf; residents of Mishti Bazar, Orakzai are seeking post-arrest bail in case FIR no. 34 dated 01-05-2020, registered under section 324/34 PPC in PS Lower Orakzai,

The facts of the case, according to FIR, are; that the complainant/injured Khalid Mehmood reported the matter to ASHO in Civil Hospital, Mishti Mela. The compliant reported that he had a guest in hujra when accused/petitioners dishonoured his guest, due to which he locked the hujra; that the accused/petitioners got angry on locking of hujra; that he was standing on the roof of his house when the accused/petitioner started firing at him with the intention to commit qatl-e-amd; that he was hit and injured in the buttock. The complaint was referred to medical treatment and report; while a murasila was sent to PS for registration of instant case.

Arguments of learned counsels for the parties and DPP for the State heard; and available record perused. The tentative assessment of which, for the purpose of deciding instant petition, shows that:

- 1. The accused/petitioner are charged directly by name in a promptly lodged FIR; the parties are known to each other and there is no chance of misidentification.
- 2. The medical report shows injury in the groin area with fracture of hip bone which is a vital part of body and an injury of serious nature.

- 3. Six empties were recovered from the spot attributed to accused/petitioners and the circumstances suggest attempt to commit qatl-e-amd.
- 4. The offence falls under prohibitory clause 497 CrPC.

In these circumstances, the instant petition is found without merit and the same is hereby **dismissed**. Let a copy of this order be placed on record; while this file be consigned to the record room after necessary completion and compilation.
