SUIT FOR DECLARATION, PERMANENT AND MANDATORY INJUNCTION

Brief facts of the case in hand are that the plaintiff, Rafi

declaration, permanent and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein wrongly mentioned as 01.01.1991 in his CNIC by the date of birth is against the facts and circumstances. That date of birth of mother of plaintiff is 01.01.1980 in her CNIC while date of birth of father of plaintiff is 1975 in his CNIC. That the difference between the age of plaintiff and his mother is 11 years only while the difference between the age of

plaintiff and his father is 16 years which is unnatural gape between the son and his parents. That defendants were repeatedly asked to correct the date of birth of plaintiff but they refused. Hence, the instant suit.

- 2. Defendants were summoned, who appeared through attorney namely Syed Farhat Abbas, and submitted their written statement.
- IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involve in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record and to this laber herefect notice was given to the parties that why not case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording pro and contra evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "to enable the court to
 - a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;
 - b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;
 - c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and
 - d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

Learned counsel for plaintiff and representative for defendants heard and record gone through.



Record reveals that plaintiff through instant suit is seeking correction of his date of birth to the effect that his correct date of birth is 03.03.1995 but defendants have wrongly mentioned the same as 01.01.1991. Plaintiff in support of his contention has produced the CNIC of his parents while representative for defendants also produced the family tree of the plaintiff. The perusal of CNICs of parents of plaintiff and family tree of plaintiff show that the difference between the age of plaintiff and his mother as 11 years while the difference between the plaintiff and his father as 16 years. Such a difference in the age of son and his parents seems to be unnatural and which establishes that the date of birth of the plaintiff has wrongly the content of the plainti

to be produced by the parties.

- 5. Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby decreed as prayed for. Defendants are directed to correct the date of birth of plaintiff as 03.03.1995 in their record and in the CNIC of the plaintiff.
- 6. Parties are left to bear their own costs.
