ORDER

DPP for State and Sanaullah Khan Advocate, counsel for accused/petitioners is present. Record already received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioners, Wajid Ullah and Abdul Wahid seek their release on bail in case FIR No. 33, dated 27.09.2019 registered U/S 9-C CNSA at Police Station Lower Orakzai, wherein they are charged for having in their possession 15000grams (15kg) Chars.

3. From the arguments and record available on file, it reveals that accused/petitioners are directly, by name charged for the day light occurrence, which occurrence was promptly reported within thirty minutes of the occurrence. Recovery of Chars was effected from the immediate possession



of the accused/petitioners. Witnesses support the version of the prosecution. Offence do fall under the prohibitory clause of Section-497 Cr.P.C. All these facts at the moment prima facie connect the accused/petitioners with the commission of offence charged for. Accordingly, they are not entitled for the concession of bail in their favour. Hence, the bail petition in hand stand dismissed being meritless.
