SUIT FOR DECLARATION & PERMANENT INJUNCTION

SUMMARY JUDGEMENT: ORDER XV-A CPC

Plaintiffs, Syed Ali Syed and Syed Munawar Abbas s/o Syed Shah Jehan, have brought the instant suit for declaration-cumpermanent injunction defendants. against the hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that the correct date of birth of the plaintiff No.1 is 05.03.2003 while it has been wrongly mentioned as 05.03.2000 by the defendants and the correct date of birth of the plaintiff No.2 is 10.06.2005 while it has been wrongly mentioned as 10.06.2003, which are against the facts and circumstances. Hence, the instant suit.

Defendants were summoned, who appeared through attorney 2. namely Syed Farhat Abbas, who stated at the bar that there is no need of filing of application on behalf of the defendants. He submitted written statement, which is placed on file.

During the scheduling conference within the meaning of order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided as per available record and there is no need of pro and contra evidence in the instant case. The primary aim and objective of recent Amendment Act 2019 in CPC is, "to enable the court to-

- a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;
- b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;

During the scheduling conference, it was pointed out that

the correct date of birth of the plaintiff No.1 namely Syed Ali

- c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and
- d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

MUHAMMAD ANAZ Syed is 05.03.2003, which is evident from the school senior Civil Judge. Certificates in shape of SSC, already present on file. Similarly, the correct date of birth of the plaintiff No.2 namely Syed Munawar Abbas is 10.06.2005, which is also evident from the SSC certificate of the plaintiff No.2. The same has not been rebutted by the defendants through counter documents. Representative of the defendants has raised traditional objections, which cannot be accepted. Further, future of the plaintiffs is dependent upon the present correction in date of birth, which cannot be ignored. No need of evidence in the instant case. Hence, the claim of the plaintiff is proved as per

the available documents and record, which are admissible in evidence.

Relief:

Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiffs succeeds and is hereby decreed as prayed for. Defendants are directed to correct the date of birth of the plaintiff No.1 namely Syed Ali Syed as 05.03.2003 and the date of birth of the plaintiff No.2 namely Syed Munawar Abbas as 10.06.2005 forthwith.

- 3. Parties are left to bear their own costs.
- 4. File be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
