accused/petitioner is charged for causing injury to Rafi Ullah with whom he has patched up the matter but as the accused/petitioner is also charged for attempting at the lives of complainant/injured Juma Khan and the eyewitness Taj Akbar by making firing at them as well; therefore, the mere compromise with the injured Rafi Ullah in the absence of any malafidi on behalf of complainant, is alone not sufficient to make him entitled to the extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail.
