Order	14/07/2023	<p>Mr. Khursheed Alam Advocate represented accused/petitioner, complainant in person along with Mr. Insaf Ali Advocate and Mr. Nisar Ahmed APP for State are in attendance.</p> <p>2. This is the disposal of Post arrest bail application presented by accused/petitioner Nazim Ali s/o Sangeen Ali resident of Qaum Ali Khel Tappa Mirwas Khel, Tehsil Lower, and District Orakzai.</p> <p>3. Ashraf Ali being complainant reported explosion of explosive substance in his dwelling house by late night against accused Nazim Ali. The complainant and his family being available in house have been terrified; whereas, the walls and gate in the house had badly been damaged. Resultantly, FIR No. 24 dated 09-07-2023 has been lodged against Nazim Ali by inserting section 3-4 of KP Exclusive Substance Act, 2015 in Police Station Kurez Boya. The petitioner on arrest has been remanded to Judicial Lockup that necessitated presentation of instant petition for bail, which is under consideration.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for accused/petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for State assisted by Mr. Insaf Ali Advocate for complainant were heard at length and file gone through.</p> <p>5. This is tentative assessment of record available on file as deep appreciation is neither required nor warranted at this stage. The accusation leveled against the petitioner in a statement was without disclosing source of information; that too, with delay of about ten hours. The occurrence has not been witnessed with ocular evidence. No confession has been recorded. Recovery of a hand grenade is shown from the spot to which the link of</p>



petitioner is yet to be established. It is night occurrence witnessed by none as well. These facts render the case as that of further inquiry.

6. For what has been discussed above, instant bail petition stands allowed subject to furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rupees One Hundred and fifty thousands (150,000/-); with two sureties; each in the like amount; to the satisfaction of this Court. File of the Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.
