






<p>Order No. 02 Continued..</p>	<p>26.06.2023</p>	<p>complainant in his report for firing and throwing stones at the complainant party, which resulted into a bruise on the upper part of scapula of Raees Khan SI, however, no specific role has been attributed to the accused/petitioner. Furthermore, neither weapon of offence has been recovered nor confession has been made by the present accused/petitioner. Record further reveals that this court has already released co-accused namely Yousaf Khan, Ashoor Khan, Aamir, Iqrar Khan and Aman Ullah on bail and thus rule of consistency cannot be ruled out.
