

1. Petitioners present through counsel and attorney.

Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 20 Nov, 2020 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

3. Petitioner No. 01. Mewa Jana (Widow), 02. Akhtar Bibi (Daughter), 03. Zahir U Din (Grandson) filed the instant application. Zahir u Din recorded his statement as PW-1, Yasin Khan as PW-2 and Muhammad Umair as PW-3 testified respectively. PW-1 produced his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/1, Death Certificate of deceased as Ex.PW-1/2, CNIC of Petitioner No. 1 as Ex.PW-1/3, CNIC of Petitioner No. 2 as Ex.PW-1/4, FRC as Ex-PW-1/5 and Bank Statement as Ex-PW-1/6. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

4. As, there is nothing in rebuttal, so therefore contention of the petitioners is believed to be correct. Therefore, the petitioners will inherit the legacy of deceased as per following shares;
