Petitioner, namely Wahid Ullah is seeking return of motorcycle bearing Registration No. S-1573, chassis No. U481689, Engine No. 3798993, Model 2013 taken into possession by the local police in case FIR No.26 dated 14.07.2023 U/S 15-AA, Police Station Kuriz Boya.

Record reveals that motorcycle in question was taken into possession by the local police in the instant case, however, today petitioner produced original documents in respect of motorcycle. Original seen and returned. As petitioner produced original registration book and other relevant documents along with original number plate regarding the motorcycle in question and the same is no more required to the local police for investigation and there is no rival claimant of the same. Detention of vehicle in question in police custody for indefinite period would also achieve no useful purpose.
