- 2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 02 Dec, 2020 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.
- Petitioner No. 01. Khayal Marjan (2nd Widow), 02. Tarkh Mewa 3. (1st Widow) 03. Naseer Ullah (Son) 04. Shahid Ullah (Son) 05. Umar Ahmed (Son) 06. Umar Farooq (Son) 07. Shabina Bibi (daughter) 08. Zainab Bibi (daughter) 09. Fozia Bibi (daughter) filed the instant application. Kamran Ullah (attorney) recorded his statement as PW-1, Irfan Ullah as PW-2 and Wajid Ullah as PW-3 testified respectively.
