Order-17 01/02/2021



Plaintiff through counsel present.

Defendant present through representative.

Evidence of the plaintiff not produced.

Perusal of the record reveals that proceedings in instant case are fixed for evidence of plaintiff since 15.07.2020 and repeatedly opportunities were provided to the plaintiff to produce his entire evidence but so far, he could not produce his evidence.

On previous date last chance with notice under order 17 rule-3 CPC was given but in-spite of notice, he failed to produce his evidence. No plausible reason was furnished by the counsel for plaintiff that why evidence could not be produced by the plaintiff today.

Record divulges that more than sufficient opportunities were provided to the plaintiff for production of his evidence but he failed to produce his evidence in-spite of notice given to him under order 17 rule-3 CPC on previous date. In attending circumstance, court is left with no option but to exercise its powers under order 17 rule-3 CPC.

By exercising such powers, the right of produce evidence by plaintiff is hereby stuck off and suit of plaintiff is dismissed for want of sufficient evidence.
