


Order No.03</p>		<p>submitted before DPO, Orakzai has made a report to the police to the fact that the accused/petitioners has forcefully stopped the mining operations of the complainant and criminally intimidated the workers of the coal mines belonging to the complainant. The report of the complainant was scribed vide Daily Dairy No. 9 of 09.06.2023 and the matter was referred to the SHO for inquiry. During inquiry the complainant further alleged that the accused/petitioner Zaliman Shah has also demanded money from the complainant. On 16.08.2023 the instant FIR was registered.</p> <p>Perusal of the case file shows that though the accused/petitioners are directly nominated in the instant FIR; however, the offences for which the accused/petitioners are charged are bailable in nature and committing of the accused/petitioners to police custody for enabling them to be released on post-arrest bail, would serve no useful purpose of the prosecution except the probability of unjustified harassment at the hands of police.</p> <p>Therefore, in the light of above, the bail petition in hand stands accepted and ad-interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioners vide order dated 19.08.2023 stands confirmed on the strength of existing bail bonds.
