SUIT FOR DECLARATION, CUM PERPETUAL AND MANDATORY INJUNCTION

SUMMARY JUDGEMENT: 16.03.2021

Brief facts of the case in hand are that the plaintiff, Mukhtar Ullah, has brought the instant suit for declaration cum perpetual and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that his correct date of birth is 02.04.2004 according to Matric Provisional Certificate and DMC(KB-126668), Kohat Board, while it has been wrongly mentioned as 02.04.2002 in his Seprest Allsh Wash

"Form-B" by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective Oralizaj al (Bapar Mala) upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. That defendants were repeatedly asked to correct the date of birth of plaintiff but they refused, hence, the instant suit.

- 2. Defendants were summoned, who appeared through their representative namely Syed Farhat Abbas, who submitted written statement.
- 3. During the scheduling conference within the meaning of order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record. To this effect notice was given to the parties that why not the case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording lengthy evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "to enable the court to
 - a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;
 - b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;
 - c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and
 - d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

Learned counsel for plaintiff and representative for defendants heard and record gone through.

Record reveals that plaintiff through instant suit is seeking correction of his date of birth to the effect that his correct date of birth is 02.04.2004 according to Matric Provisional Certificate and DMC(KB-126668), Kohat Board, while it has been wrongly mentioned as 02.04.2002 in his "Form-B" by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of

the plaintiff and liable to correction. Plaintiff in support of his contention produced the copies of his Matric Provisional Certificate and DMC, Kohat Board wherein the date of birth of the plaintiff has been mentioned as 02.04.2004. So, the Matric Provisional Certificate and DMC, Kohat Board, of the plaintiff clearly negates the incorporation of his date of birth as 02.04.2002 in his "Form-B". Further, there is no countered document available with the defendants to rebut the documents produced by the plaintiff in support of his stance. Hence, in these circumstances, the said documents are admissible and reliance is placed on it and is sufficient to decide the fate of the case and no further evidence is required to be produced by the parties. So, the available record clearly establishes the claim of the plaintiff.

 Recommendation of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby decreed as prayed for. Defendants are directed to correct the date of birth of plaintiff as 02.04.2004 in their record and in the "Form-B" of the plaintiff.
 - 6. Parties are left to bear their own costs.
