Petitioners have filed instant petition for issuance of amended succession certificate to the effect that petition for issuance of succession certificate in respect of legacy of Ahmad Ali was filed and succession certificate was issued on 10.06.2020 however, in petition for succession only the outstanding debts in foreign country were mentioned and inadvertently the amount Rs. 400,000 in Overseas Pakistani Foundation were not mentioned in the petition and as result of which such amount and Overseas Pakistani Foundation (OPF) were also not mentioned in succession certificate. Petitioners have requested for mentioning the OPF as a debtor in amended succession certificate.


Perusal of the record reveals that petitioners filed a petition for issuance of succession certificate in respect of debts left by their predecessor namely Abdur Rehman in foreign county and accordingly succession certificate was issued by this court on 10.06.2020. Now it is the contention of petitioners that their predecessor has also left some amount in Overseas Pakistani Foundation (OPF). The request for issuance of amended succession certificate seems genuine on the ground mentioned
