BA No. 24 of 2021 Akhtar Man Shah Vs State

ORDER 13.02.2021

Learned counsel for the accused/petitioner present. Mr Amir Shah APP for the State present.

Accused/petitioner Akhatar Man Shah s/o Ghulam Shah r/o Rabia Khel, Tapa Ayaz Khel, Kada Ghiljo District Orakzai is seeking his post arrest bail in case FIR No. 06 dated 31/01/2021 u/sec 302/324/353/436/427/148/149 PPC PS Upper Orakzai wherein three deceased persons were murdered and two other persons got injured during counter firing.

Arguments for the learned counsel for the accused/petitioner and learned APP for the state heard and record perused.

The tentative assessment of record would evince that thirty one co-accused of accused/petitioner charged in the instant case are released on bail by this court vide order dated 11-02-2021 and the case of accused/petitioner is at far with that of the accused already released on bail, therefore under the principle of consistency the accused/petitioner is also entitled to be release on bail being charged for similar role is that of co-accused to whom bail is granted. Furthermore the accused remained in the custody of police however neither the accused/petitioner confessed his guilt nor the recovery of any weapon of offence has been effected from him. The accused/petitioner is interrogated in the instant case and is no more required for any further investigation, therefore the case of the accused/petitioner is arguable for the grant of bail.

In view of the above discussion the bail petition is accepted and the accused/petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing surety bond in the sum of Rs. 200, 000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties must be local and men of means.
