

DPP, Umar Niaz for the state present. Accused/petitioners, Saeed Khan and Zulfiqar on ad-interim bail with Muzahir Hussain Advocate present. Complainant, Mujahid Khan present alongwith Javid Muhammad Advocate.

(2). At the very outset, complainant produced compromise Ex. PA. The statement of complainant recorded separately wherein he deposed that he has patched up the matter with the above-named accused/petitioners, and on the basis of said compromise, he has got no objection upon the acceptance of BBA petition in hand in respect of above-named accused/petitioners.

(3). Since, the offence is not compoundable but however in number of judgments of the superior courts, it is held that bail can be granted even in non-compoundable offence as it would bury the hatchets between the parties and pave a way for peaceful resolution of the matter. From the compromise produced in black and white, this court is satisfied that a genuine compromise between the parties has taken place, and accordingly, the said compromise is accepted and on the basis of compromise, the BBA petition in hand stand accepted and the interim bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioners is confirmed on the existing bonds.
