ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for State and Syed Muzahir Advocate for accused/petitioner. Complainant, Mujahid Khan also present. Record received.

(2). Accused/petitioner, Muhammad Ayaz seeks his release on bail in case FIR no. 26, dated 20.02.2021, u/s 392/506/34 PPC of PS Lower Orakzai, wherein he alongwith two others is charged for criminal intimidation and snatching motorcar of complainant, Mujahid Khan at gun point.


(3). At the very outset, complainant produced compromise Ex. PA. The statement of complainant recorded separately wherein he deposed that he has patched up the matter with the above-named accused/petitioner, and on the basis of said compromise, he has got no objection upon the acceptance of bail petition in hand as well as upon his release in respect of above-named accused/petitioner.

(4). Since, the offence is not compoundable but however in number of judgments of the superior courts, it is held that bail can be granted even in non-compoundable offence as it would bury the hatchets between the parties and pave a way for peaceful resolution of the matter. From the compromise produced in black and white, this court is satisfied that a genuine compromise between the parties has taken place, and accordingly, the said compromise is accepted and on the basis of compromise, the bail petition in hand stands accepted subject to furnishing of bail bonds in sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court.
