

2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 23 Feb,2021 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.
3. Petitioner No. 01. Abdul Salam (Son), 02. Abdul Basit (Son) 03. Zeenat Bibi (Daughter) 04. Salma Bibi (Daughter) filed the instant application. Abdul Salam (attorney) recorded his statement as PW-1, Muhammad Zubair as PW-2 and Syed Muhammad Owais as PW-3 testified respectively. 
