Accused/petitioners Jumma Khan s/o Khan Mast and Danish Khan s/o Nawroz Khan r/o Qoam Feroz Khel, Chappari Feroz Khel District Orakzai are seeking post-arrest bail in case FIR No.39 dated 24/03/2021 u/s 457/380/506/34 PPC of PS Lower Orakzai (Kalaya) wherein the accused/petitioners are charged for the commission of offense of theft from the house of complainant

Arguments of the learned counsel for the accused/petitioners and arguments of learned APP for the state assisted by the learned counsel for the complainant heard and record perused.

The perusal of record after its tentative assessment would transpire that the report was registered with an unexplained delay. The accused/petitioners after their arrest in the case were interrogated during custody but no recovery has been effected from their possession nor the accused/petitioners made confession. Furthermore, there is no previous involvement of the accused/petitioners in such like cases. At present on the available record nothing incriminating is available to prima facia connect the accused/petitioners with the commission of offense. The fact and circumstance of the case make the case of accused/petitioners one of further inquiry, hence their case are arguable

for the grant of bail.

The sureties must be local and men of means.
