

## IN THE COURT OF FARMAN ULLAH SENIOR CIVIL JUDGE, ORAKZAI AT BABER MELA

Petitioners through attorney and counsel present.

The petitioners seek succession certificate in respect of legacy of deceased namely Nazar Hussain, who died on 30/10/2013. Evidence recorded and closed. Arguments heard and record perused.

- 2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.
- 3. Petitioner No. 01. Mst Bailawar Jan (widow), 02. Mudassir Hussain (Son), 03. Alia Begum (Daughter) 04. Mubassir Hussain (Son) 05. Sagheer Hussain (Son) filed the instant application. Sagheer Hussain (attorney) recorded his statement as PW-1, Tajdar Hussain as PW-2 and Nadeem Hussain as PW-3 testified respectively. PW-1 submitted power of attorney as Ex.PW-1/1, his CNIC as Ex.PW-1/2, death certificate as Ex.PW-1/3, CNIC of petitioner No. 1 as Ex.PW-1/4, CNIC of petitioner No. 2 as Ex.PW-1/5, CNIC of petitioner No. 3 as Ex.PW-1/6, CNIC of petitioner No. 4 as Ex.PW-1/7, CNIC of deceased as Ex.PW-1/8, bank statement as Ex.PW-1/9. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.
- 4. As, there is nothing in rebuttal, so therefore contention of the petitioners is believed to be correct. Therefore, the petitioners will inherit the legacy of deceased as per following shares;

Original succession certificate be given to the petitioners' subject to surety bonds while copy of the certificate be placed on file.
