1. Petitioners through attorney and through counsel present.

The petitioners seek succession certificate in respect of legacy of deceased namely Fazal Karim, who died on 26/10/2020. Petitioner's evidence recorded and closed. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Through publication in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated; 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 general public was asked to submit objections, if any, however, no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were conducted.

3. Petitioner No. 01. Mst; Qadar Meena (Widow), 02. Zafar Iqbal (Son), 03. Mujeeb Ur Rehman (Son), 04. Roshan Bibi (Daughter), 05. Hijran Bibi (Daughter), 06. Hafsa Bibi (Daughter) filed the instant application. Habib Rehman (attorney) recorded his statement as PW-3, Wasal Khan PW-2 and Waheed Ullah as PW-1 testified respectively. PW-3 submitted power of attorney as Ex.PW-3/1, Copy of CNIC as Ex,PW-3/2, Copy of death certificate of deceased as Ex.PW-3/3, Copy of account bank statement as Ex.PW-3/4, FRC as Ex.PW-3/5, Form-B of petitioner No. 3 as Ex.PW-3/6, CNIC of petitioner No. 4 as Ex.PW-3/7, CNIC of petitioner No. 5 as Ex.PW-3/8 and copy of CNIC of petitioner No. 2 as Ex.PW-3/9. All the exhibited documents, publication and report of process server etc. are placed on file. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

4. As, there is nothing in rebuttal, so therefore contention of the petitioners is believed to be correct. Therefore, the petitioners will inherit the legacy of deceased as per following shares;



If any legal heir/objector appear in future, the petitioners and the sureties will be responsible for the payment. Parties are left to bear their own cost. Original succession certificate be given to the petitioners' subject to surety bonds while copy of the certificate be placed on file.
