Moreover, regarding the same occurrence the accused Ikram Hussain has also made a report to the police vide daily diary of 10.04.2021 wherein the present complainant, Mehboob Ali and his injured brother, Diyar Ali are charged as accused for beating the accused party, therefore, being cross cases, it is yet to be determined during the trial that which of the party is aggressor and whom is aggressed upon.
