Sureties namely Mubashir Khan and Sadeel Khan present. Malak Zeri Gul present. Replies to show cause notices u/s 514 Cr.PC submitted. Record gone through.


Record reveals that Mubashir Khan and Sadeel Khan stood sureties for the accused Rehmat Ullah for an amount of Rs. 50,000/- each in case FIR No. 31 dated 04.04.2023 u/s 392, 15-AA and 05 Explosive Substances Act, PS Kalaya. During the trial, they failed to produce the said accused before the court, resultantly, accused was proceeded against U/S 512 Cr. PC and sureties were proceeded U/S 514 Cr. PC.

In reply to the show cause, sureties have contended that they are young and jobless persons. They stood sureties of the accused on humanitarian ground and that accused is their close relative and have lastly requested for lenient view.

There is nothing on record which could show that they have gained any financial benefits from the accused. Prima facie, they stood sureties for the accused on social and humanitarian ground. Accused is their close relative, therefore, a lenient view is taken and sureties are burdened with penalty of Rs.5000/- each.
