Accused/petitioner, Wajid Rehman seeks his
pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 73, dated
08.06.2021 registered U/S 9 (c) KP CNSA at
Police Station Kalaya Lower Orakzai, wherein he
is charged for having 700 grams Chars in his
possession.

It is evident from the record that through the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR and recovery of chars has been shown made from his possession, however the place of occurrence is a public place and the occurrence has allegedly taken place during broad daylight but witness from the public has been associated with the process of

search or recovery. Moreover, the offence carries punishment up to 7 years and as such it does not attract the prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.P.C. Accused/petitioner, after his arrest, has gone through the process of investigation but he has neither confessed nor admitted his guilt. Furthermore, investigation in the instant case is complete and the accused/petitioner is no more required to the police for further investigation.

- 4. Accordingly, for the reasons briefly mentioned above, bail petition in hand stand accepted and the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
- 5. Police record be returned and file of this court be consigned to record room.
