APP for the state present. Accused Asif Nawaz and Khalid Nawaz along with complainant Zakir Ullah and his elder brother namely Naseem Ullah appeared and submitted application for early hearing of the case. APP for the state conceded the same. Case file requisitioned for today. Complainant Zakir Ullah and his elder brother Naseem Ullah stated at the bar that they have already entered into compromise with accused facing trial and their joint statement has already been recorded on 11.10.2023 as a result of which co-accused Noor Zali has already been acquitted, therefore, they have got no objection if accused facing trial are acquitted from the charges leveled against them. Record shows that co-accused namely Noor Zali has already been acquitted on the basis of compromise vide order dated: 11.10.2023, resultantly, accused Asif Nawaz and Khalid Nawaz are hereby acquitted from charges u/s 324, 337 F(iii) PPC. They are on bail. Their bail bonds stand cancelled. Sureties are discharged from their liability.

Accused Asif Nawaz submitted application to the effect that he wants to plead his guilt for offence u/s 15-AA and requested for lenient view.

As per record, accused has been charged for possessing one pistol 30 bore bearing No. A141565 long with fixed charger containing 02 live rounds of the same.

Formal charge framed. The accused pleaded his guilt. After pleading his guilt, show cause notice under section 243 Cr.P.C. was given to the accused as to why he should not be convicted. Resultantly, he prayed for lenient view while placing himself at the mercy of this court.

Keeping in mind the wholehearted confession of guilt by the accused being a first offender, a lenient view is taken. Accused is convicted and sentenced with fine of Rs.500/- and imprisonment till rising of the court. Case property confiscated to the state.
