## ARIF KHAN VS THE STATE

## **ORDER**

DPP, Umar Niaz for State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present.

Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

- Accused/petitioner, Arif Khan s/o Multan Khan seeks his pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 22, dated 15.06.2021 registered U/S 9 (d) KP CNSA at Police Station Ghiljo, wherein as per contents of FIR the local police while present on the spot, searched the person of the accused/petitioner on the basis suspicion and recovered 1110 grams of chars from his possession.
- 3. It is evident from the record that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR and recovery of chars has been shown made from personal possession of the accused/petitioner, however the place of occurrence is a public place and the occurrence has allegedly taken place

during broad daylight but no effort has been made to associate any witness from the public with the process of search or recovery. Moreover, the FSL report is not available on file to show nature of the substance recovered. Accused/petitioner, after his has gone through the process investigation but he has neither confessed nor admitted his guilt. Furthermore, investigation in the instant is complete case and the accused/petitioner is no more required to the police for further investigation.

- 4. Accordingly, for the reasons mentioned above, bail petition in hand stand accepted and the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
- 5. Police record be returned and file of this court be consigned to record room.
